13	SAUVIGNON GRIS, GRISET, IGP D'OC, FRANCE This wine has all the wonderfully tropicalnotes that we have come to love from drinking sauvignon blanc, but with slightly less of the cutting acidity.	£15.95
14	CHABLIS, DOMAINE DES ILES GERARD TREMBLAY, FRANCE Gerard Tremblay produces the most elegant style of Chablis - very mineral, clean and unspoilt by excessive oak. An old fashioned & worthy style. Good honeyed fruit on the nose with crisp, steely fruit on the palate, gives a wine of great finesse.	£24.50
15	SANCERRE BLANC, DOMAINE BONNARD, FRANCE Delicious and expressive, combining the best of Loire Valley sauvignon blanc with a hint of the New Zealand style. Look for lime zest and mineral, cut grass and a touch of fresh flowers.	£29.5O

24	CROZES HERMITAGE, ETIENNE BARRET, FRANCE 100% Syrah with classic aromas of bramble and a little spice. Oak flavours are restrained to let the fruit shine through. Medium to full bodied and easy to drink!	£29.5O
25	FITOU, DOMAINE JONES IGP CÔTES CATALANES, FRANCE Deep ruby. Lots of crunchy red fruits, redcurrant and a touch of raspberry. Very clean and lively. The tannins are subtle and structured. Full of fresh acidity and highly enjoyable.	£34.95
26	RIOJA RESERVA, BODEGAS CAMPILLO, SPAIN Deep, complex aromas with very developed hint of fruit, leather and vanilla. On the palate, it is powerful and full-bodied with a well-balanced tannic flavour on the finish.	£24.95
27	CHIANTI, LA VIGNA, ITALY A lovely, simple style of Chianti that really shows off the primary fruit flavours of the Sangiovese grape. Lots of red cherry fruit backed up by a gentle structure.	£16.5O
28	SHIRAZ, HILLTOPS, CHALKERS CROSSING, AUSTRALIA Is there anything this winery does not excel at? This Shiraz is another absolute cracker. The nose shows blackberry, cherries and vanilla, whilst the palate oozes raspberries, black and white pepper, mint and a hint of coffee.
